What is a Quality Assurance Program?

As an Evidential Breath Tester (EBT) manufacturer, Lifeloc Technologies is obligated to put a set of criteria into place to ensure the accuracy of the breath testing device which must be approved by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), a division of DOT, before the breath testing device is added to the conforming products list as an Approved Evidential Breath Measurements Device by ODAPC. This ensures proper use and performance of the device in accordance with DOT 49 CFR Part 40 regulations.

The QAP can be found in the first few pages of the EBT's User's Manual which is provided with all new devices. If the User's Manual has been misplaced, a new bound copy may be purchased or a PDF copy of the User's Manual or QAP alone may be requested by contacting Lifeloc directly.

Why is the QAP important?

As a user of the EBT, it is your responsibility to be familiar with all aspects of the device including the information out lined in the Quality Assurance Program. This should be read prior to or as a part of your BAT qualification training and referenced often while using the device.

The QAP covers important pieces of information such as approved methods for calibration checks, specific minimum intervals for performing calibration checks, specific tolerances which determine if the device is within proper calibration as well as specific inspection, maintenance and calibration requirements and intervals for the instrument.

The QAP also references when to remove the device from service for a calibration or service from the factory, which includes when the device fails a Calibration Check or requires calibration three times in three consecutive months.
